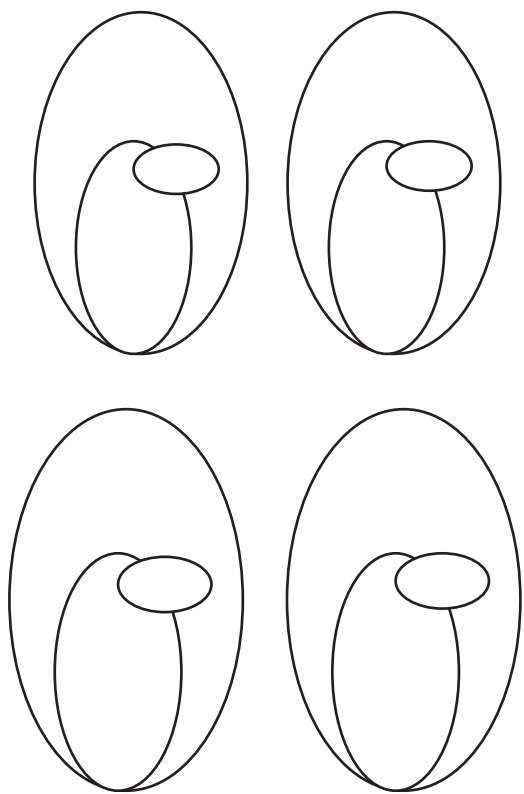


Chocolate Bat

1. Start by tracing the outline of the bat with chocolate.
2. Once the outline is set, you can fill in the bat or choose to only have the outline.
3. Leave to harden.
4. Carefully pick up with a thin metal spatula and place on your baked goods!

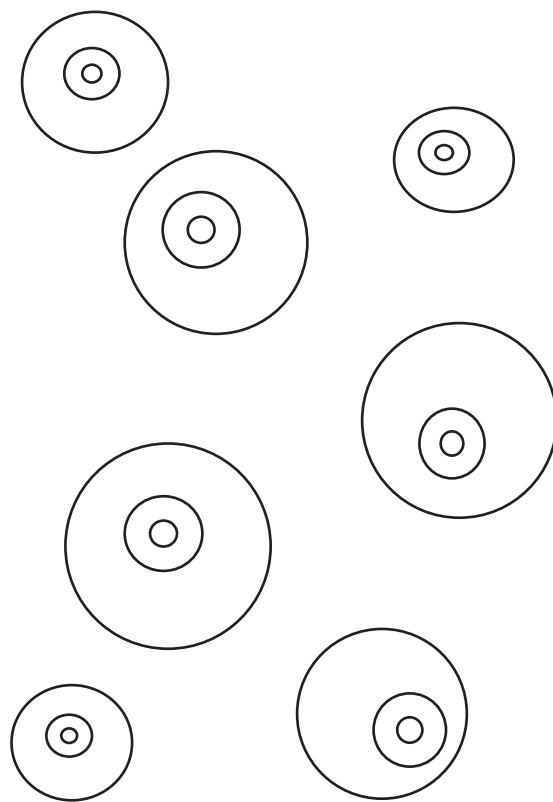




Chocolate Eyes

1. Start by adding white chocolate to the outer most oval.
2. Once the outer layer is set, fill in the inner oval with dark chocolate.
3. Leave to harden. Finally, over top, add a layer of white chocolate to the top, smallest oval.
4. Carefully pick up and place on your baked goods!

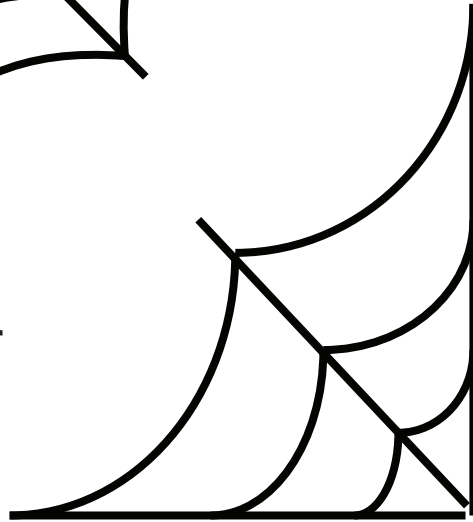
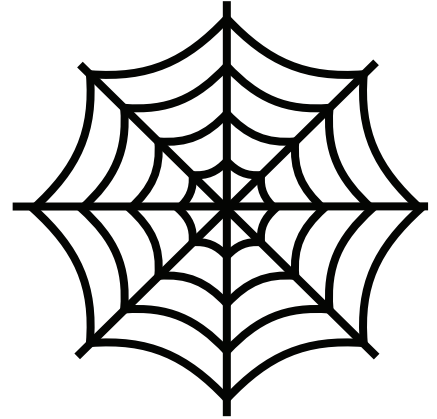
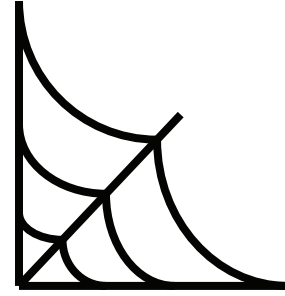
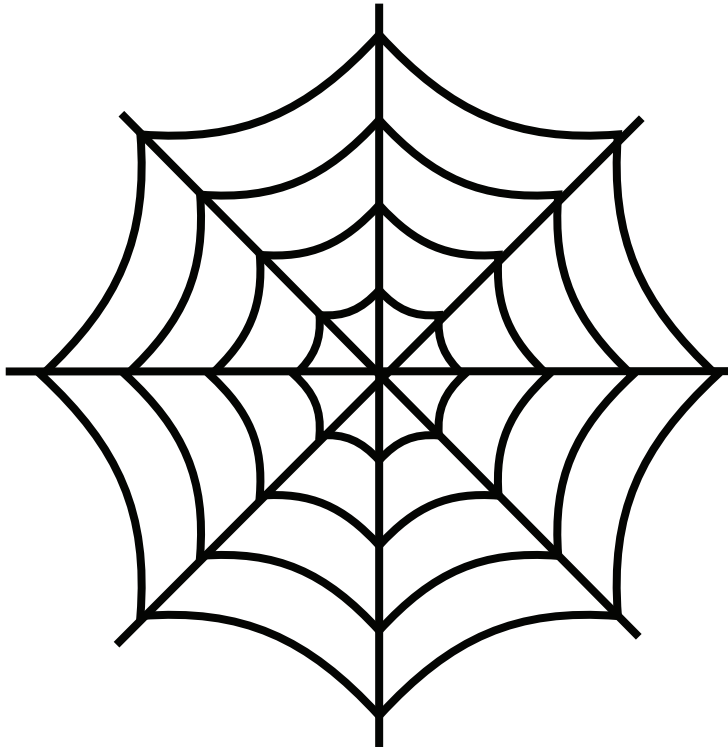

Monster Eyes

1. Start by adding white chocolate to the outer most circle.
2. Right away, add an M&M to the white chocolate. Let it set.
3. Finally, on top of the M&M, add a small dot of dark chocolate to the top. Let it set.
4. Carefully pick up and place on your baked goods!

Chocolate Spider Web

1. Start by tracing the straight lines with your chocolate.
2. Once the straight lines set, trace the curved lines to make the spider web design.
3. Leave to harden.
4. Carefully pick up with a thin metal spatula and place on your baked goods!
